## 1. BAND SIZE

To determine your size using the Pin-up Girls bra patterns, you need only two measurements. It doesn't matter if you use inches or centimeters, just as long as you use the same for both measurements. Measure the high bust, pulling the tape snug against the skin but not tight. The high bust measurement determines your band size.



## 2. CUP SIZE

Now measure over the fullest part of the bust, but do not pull the tape snug, just tight enough to keep it from sliding down. This is the full bust measurement. To determine the cup size, subtract the high bust from the full bust measurement.

## **Band size**

The chart below should help determine your band size:
